Summer Term After School Activity Clubs

Dear Parents/carers,

Attached is a list of all the activity clubs including our **new** badminton, rounders, table tennis, cooking and young engineers clubs, that will be running next term, and details of how to book them. Bookings will open on Monday 27th March.

Clubs run by SASM staff can be booked via ParentMail or by handing a named, sealed envelope containing either the correct money or a cheque made out to St Andrew's & St Mark's Junior School to the school office. Bookings will be processed by the finance department and no change can be given, or part payments accepted, by the front office staff.

Bookings for drama club should be made online via www.dramaworkshops.biz

Bookings for gymnastics should be made online via www.englishsportsgroup.com

Bookings for engineering club should be made online via www.stemkids.co.uk

Bookings for chess, Tiger Tennis, CraftyKnits, and LazerLions should be made by handing in a cheque to the office in a sealed envelope labelled with your child's name and the club you are booking for. If booking for more than one club you will need a separate envelope and cheque for each one. Details of the cheque payees are attached. Cash payments can also be accepted by handing in a named, sealed envelope containing the correct payment.

Families eligible for Pupil Premium Grant are entitled to book a place at one after school activity club and an additional place at a sports club free of charge. These places can only be booked via the school office during the ppg booking period Friday 24th March- Tuesday 28th March.

Clubs will start w/c 24th April (with the exception of gymnastics which will have a session on Friday 21st April and engineering club which will not start until 2nd May) and finish w/ending 7th July.

There will be no clubs running on Friday 16th June as the PTA summer SASMfest will be taking place.

Clubs start straight after school and finish at 4.30pm. All children must have signed and abide by the club code of conduct in their planner, **including changing back into their school uniform after a sports club.** Children should be collected by a responsible adult after a club unless you have given written consent for your child to walk home on their own.
